

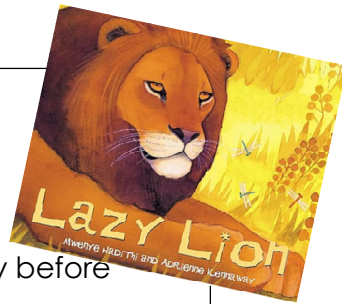

- To create and debug simple programs using 2Code Chimp

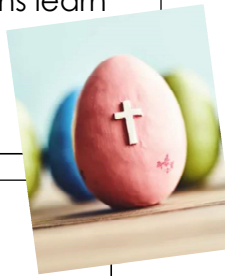
PSHE
