Milford School provides opportunities for all children to develop as independent, confident, creative and successful learners with high aspirations.

Woodland school

Woodland school is held off-site locally at the Witley Centre with all Key Stage One children attending a full day of Woodland School each half term. Reception children begin Woodland School in the summer term.

Woodland School learning is integrated with our existing class curriculum so that children can develop their knowledge and skills in the outdoor classroom. There is a high focus on developing the 'character' of children such as resilience, independence and courage, and wider skills such as: teamwork, problem solving and critical thinking.

Activities include: den building, map reading, plant and animal identification, fire lighting and of course the all-important roasting of marshmallows!

We understand that balancing work/life and childcare is a challenge, which is why we offer our own in-house breakfast club which runs from 7:45am to school start time.

The club is held in our hall and, in addition to breakfast, a host of resources and games are available. Breakfast Club costs £5.50 per day and we accept childcare vouchers.

We have a strong relationship with our neighbouring Orchard After School Club who collect Milford children from school and then accompany them on a short walk through the playground to the After School Club where they have a meal, activities and chill out time until they are collected up until 6pm.
