SCARECROW COMPETITION ENTRY RULES

ELIGIBILITY:

OPEN TO ALL LOCAL SCHOOLS AND NURSERIES.
 ENTRIES CAN BE SUBMITTED BY INDIVIDUAL CLASSES OR YEAR GROUPS.
 MULTIPLE ENTRIES FROM THE SAME SCHOOL OR NURSERY ARE PERMITTED.

SCARECROW DESIGN REQUIREMENTS:

ORIGINALITY: SCARECROWS MUST BE ENTIRELY ORIGINAL AND CREATED FROM SCRATCH.
 MATERIALS: USE ANY MATERIALS YOU LIKE, BUT ENSURE THEY ARE DURABLE ENOUGH TO WITHSTAND ALL WEATHER CONDITIONS.

THEME: THERE IS NO SPECIFIC THEME, BUT ALL SCARECROWS MUST BE FAMILY-FRIENDLY
 SIZE: NO SIZE RESTRICTIONS, BUT ENSURE YOUR SCARECROW CAN BE EASILY TRANSPORTED AND DISPLAYED.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

ALL SCARECROWS MUST BE DROPPED OFF AT WILLINGHURST ESTATE OR READY FOR COLLECTION BY TUESDAY 15TH OCTOBER.
 ENSURE YOUR ENTRY IS CLEARLY LABELED WITH THE SCHOOL OR NURSERY NAME AND THE CLASS/YEAR GROUP RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CREATION.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

CREATIVITY AND ORIGINALITY: HOW UNIQUE AND IMAGINATIVE IS THE SCARECROW?
 CRAFTSMANSHIP: THE QUALITY AND DURABILITY OF THE CONSTRUCTION.
 VISUAL IMPACT: DOES THE SCARECROW HAVE THAT "WOW" FACTOR?

JUDGING AND VOTING:

A PANEL OF JUDGES WILL EVALUATE THE SCARECROWS ON SATURDAY, 26TH OCTOBER.
 PUBLIC VOTING WILL BE OPEN THROUGHOUT THE DISPLAY PERIOD, FROM 16TH OCTOBER TO 31ST OCTOBER.
