I trained as a dancer at Elmhurst Ballet School and as a teacher at the Royal Academy of Dance HQ. After graduation I completed my B.Ed (hons) alongside teaching. The first half of my career was spent teaching in Kenya, Ireland, ~~USA~~ China. In 2006 I settled in Milford and have run **Milford and Brook School of Dance**. In that time the school has grown to include all levels up to Grade 8 and now Vocational Grades and **Adult Ballet**. Children can join our **Baby Ballet** from 2 1/2 years

Each year we perform at the Milford Fete and biannually we mount a full length ballet performance. To date we have performed: Sleeping Beauty, Coppelia, The Nutcracker, Giselle and Alice in Wonderland.

In 2019 we opened our first **Silver Swans** Class, Ballet classes aimed at over 55s and now offer 5 classes per week to over 50 seniors.
